Submission Guidelines

- Please limit abstracts to 500 words. If you would like to submit a longer conspectus (see criteria below), please submit an abstract as well.
- Please submit your conspectus in the following format:
 - **Software:** Microsoft Word.
 - **Titles:** Capitalize the first letter of each word, bold and center the title on the page.
 - **Authors:** Authors and author affiliations are centered on the page.
 - - Identify the author giving the presentation with an asterix.

- For those interested in submitting a conspectus

Length: To facilitate the flexible format of the Forum, conspectus may be from a minimum of one page to a maximum of 5 pages, including all Tables and Figures. Do not number lines or pages.

Tables: Tables may be incorporated into the body of the text or appear at the end of the document. Tables should be numbered consecutively and have a title that appears at the top of the table.

Figures: Figures may be incorporated into the body of the text or appear at the end of the document. Figures should be numbered consecutively and have a title that appears at the bottom of the figure.
